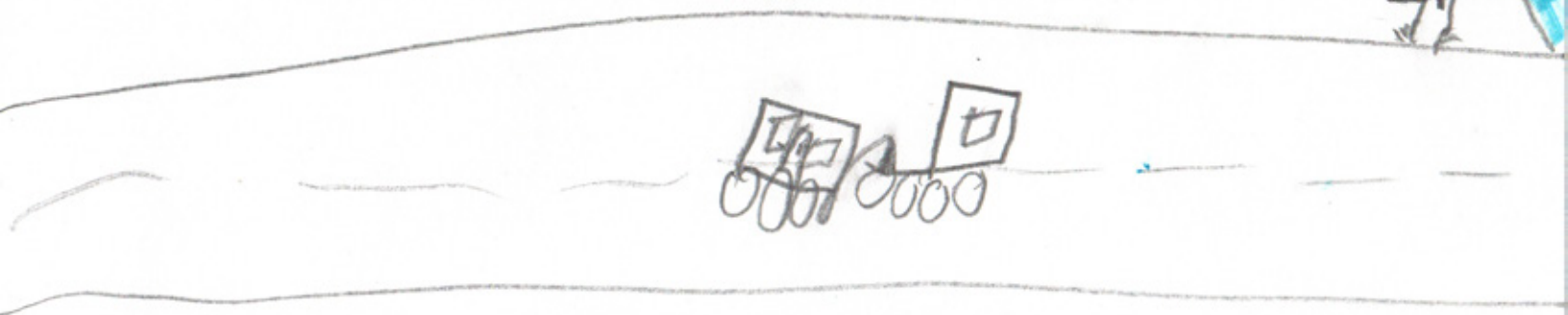
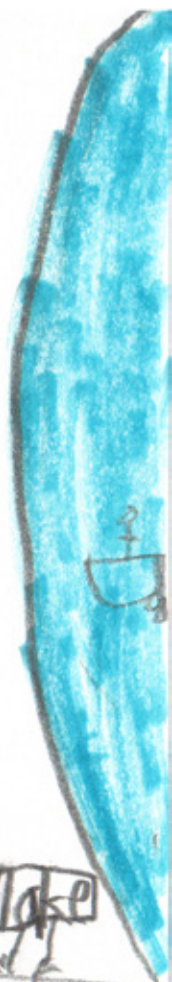
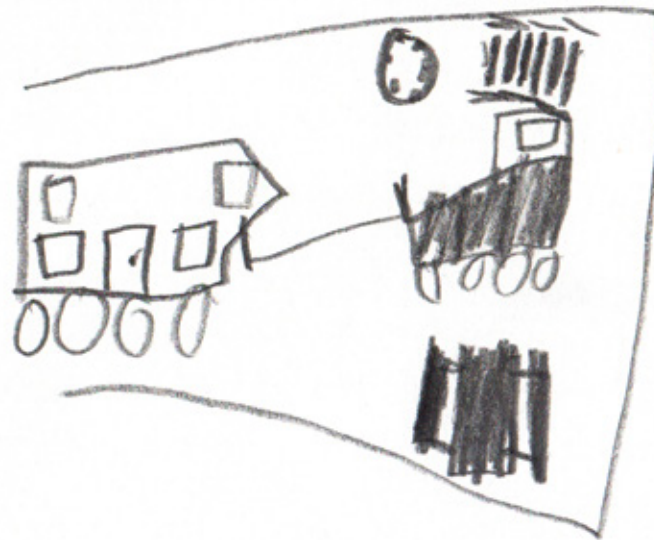


Dad's Birthday Weekend at Wilson Lake

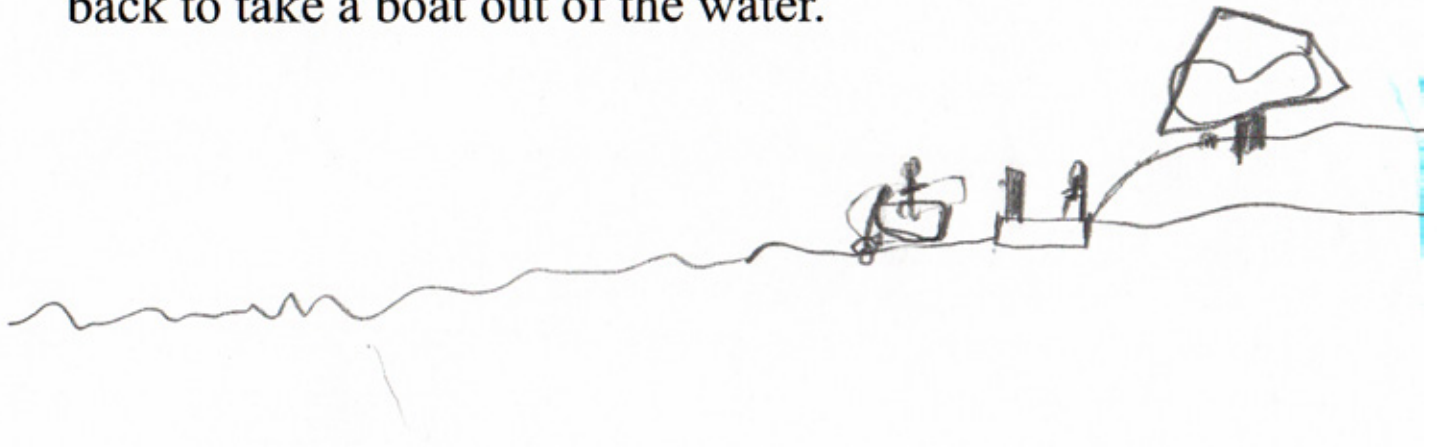
We went to the lake and unhitched the camper. Next we unpack the firewood. I'm feeling pretty excited about it.



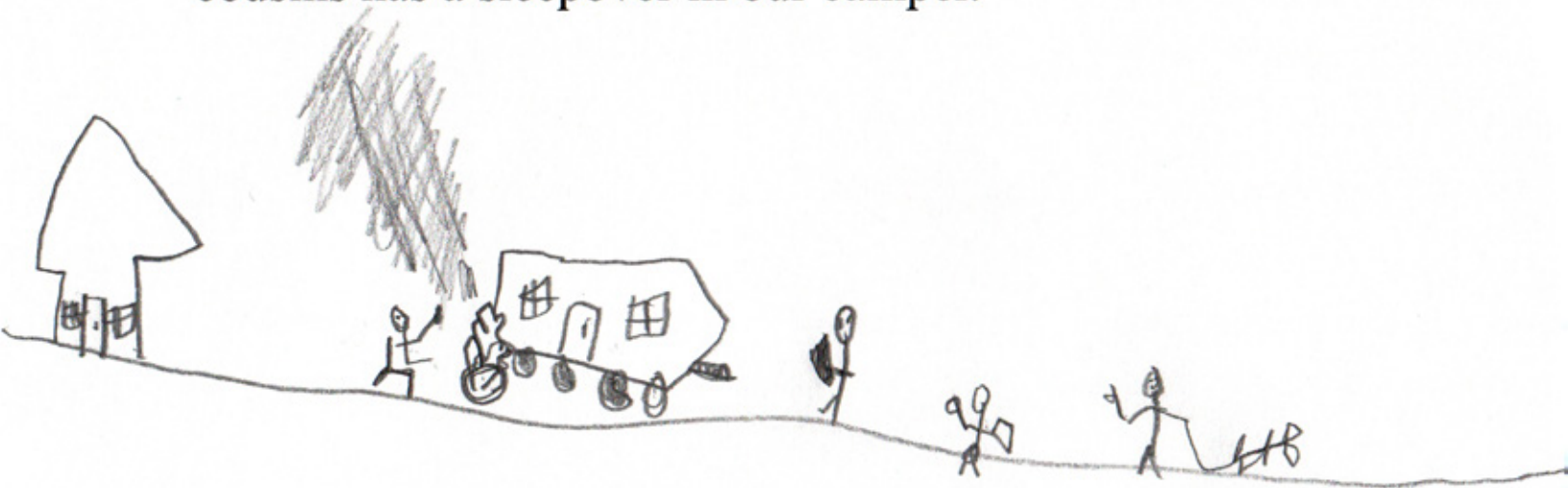
We put the boat in the water. My sister and I see lots of tiny fish. But the boat wasn't wanting to start. Luckily my uncle had some batteries in the back for his truck.

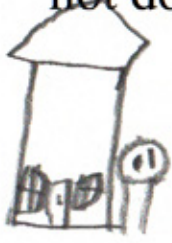
Me and my cousins find logs and sticks for the fire pit.

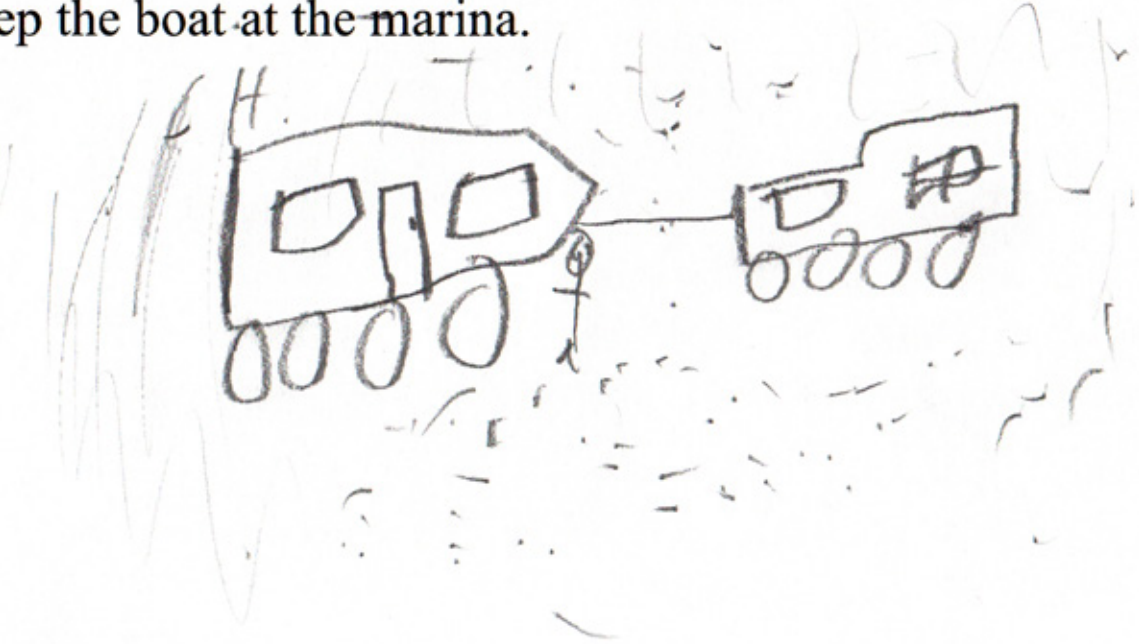
Before we knew it, it was lunch time. My parents cooked hot dogs and cheeseburgers.
